The traineeship will focus on production, packaging and selling wines. In summertime he/she will also assist with bottling, labeling, tasting and selling wines. The trainee may also help with the vegetable garden and a little orchard.

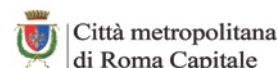

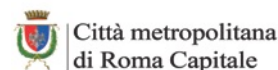
